It facilitates the metadata tagging of assets in your natural language, their discoverability, and archiving of those assets.</i></p> <p>Standard Working Storage <i>Description: The SAN is a Quantum StorNext7 server located in the Rex and Alice A Martin Media Center. The SAN is temporary or “working” storage for live assets needed for editing before they are archived and is not meant to be a permanent storage solution.</i></p> <p>ND Studios Staff Support <i>Description: A program manager for digital asset management within ND Studios and Teaching & Learning Technologies assists departmental CatDV implementation, training and consultation on asset catalog structure, metadata and operational management.</i></p>	<p>\$2,617 annually</p>
<p>Standard Tape Production Storage <i>Description: Standard Tape Production Storage is the baseline production solution for assets in the CatDV Asset Management Service that have reached the end of their active utility and can safely be migrated off of the SAN working storage server. These are secondary archive solutions to protect content deemed critical enough to warrant cloud, off-premise safe storage.
